

Field Service Technician

40+ hours per week

Identify, adjust and repair equipment and Vehicles

Physical Requirements:

Stand or walk frequently and for long duration's.

Manual dexterity and the ability to use hands and arms to grasp, reach for, handle and assemble or manipulate objects.

Lift and carry materials and tools weighing up to 50 pounds.

Climb up and down ladders and other objects.

Stoop, kneel, crouch and crawl in construction areas, including confined spaces.

Hear (naturally or with correction) on sites where the hearing of backup alarms or other sounds maybe required.

Meet the physical requirements necessary to safely and effectively perform assigned duties for up to 12 hours a day in hot and cold weather conditions.

Typical Duties:

Find malfunctions in equipment with the use of testing instruments, dials, and gauges.

Use hydraulic jacks or hoists in order to raise heavy equipment or trucks.

Fix and or move different safety devices.

Change oil, check batteries, lubricate equipment and machinery.

Read operating manuals, blueprints and technical drawings

Dismantle and reassemble equipment.

Test machines and equipment to ensure operating correctly.

Perform various other duties as assigned by supervisor.

General Requirements, Skills and Knowledge:

Ability to read and understand signs and written warnings and directions.

Ability to work without close supervision.

Ability to work within precise limits or standards of accuracy.

Ability to apply shop mathematics to solve problems.

Ability to plan work in a logical sequence and to select proper tools.

Ability to compare and see differences in the size, shape, and form of lines, figures, and objects.

Ability to picture solid objects from drawings or diagrams.

Ability to perform a variety of duties, which may change often.

Knowledge of and ability to follow all applicable safety standards at all times.
